 - 4) Applications will not be considered complete until a \$10 entry fee is paid.
 - 5) Each contestant must turn in a color headshot photo (no larger than 4x6) with the application. Please put the contestant's name on the back of the photo. (This does not have to be a professional photo.)
- 6) No changes can be made to their talent (type, song changes, etc.) after applications are submitted.
